

**Kenosha County Budget Analysis**  
**Erin Deckers Partisan Voting Record - Don't be fooled.**

*Supervisor Decker voted "No" on 11 out of 14 responsible budgets. The 2024 levy increase by Kerkman was 2.72%. Jim Kreuser's budgets were lower than Kerkmans last budget 7 out of 12 years. Erin Decker voted no 6 times on budgets that were lower than the 2024 budget she voted yes for. Decker is a UNPRINCIPLED PARTISAN. Kerkman had her one year splash and she is now increasing the levy with the support of Erin Decker.*
