COMPLAINT

I, Michael Skalitzky, allege that:

Upon information and belief, Monica Yuhas, 11626 47th Avenue, Pleasant Prairie, WI, coordinated with Onward Wisconsin, a political action committee, ID 0501715, during the 2018 Spring Election. This coordination was facilitated by Dustin Beth of 3160 136th Avenue, Kenosha, WI. Beth was a volunteer for Onward Wisconsin and also a volunteer for the Monica Yuhas for County Board Supervisor campaign. Beth designed mailings for Onward Wisconsin and also designed literature, managed the Facebook page, campaigned directly for, and owns Badger State Communications, the consulting company used by the Monica Yuhas for County Board Supervisor campaign.

Upon information and belief, Monica Yuhas for County Board Supervisor violated Wisconsin State Statute 11.1101(3)k when Onward Wisconsin sent out a mailer in support of Monica Yuhas for County Board Supervisor. The cost of that mailer exceeded the allowed limit under 11.1101(3)k for contributions to a candidate from a Political Action Committee when the PAC coordinates with a campaign.

Upon information and belief, Monica Yuhas coordinated with Kenosha Cares Coalition, an independent expenditure committee, ID 1100114, during the 2020 Spring Election. This coordination was facilitated by Dustin Beth. Badger State Communications, owned by Dustin Beth, was a paid consultant by Kenosha Cares Coalition and also a consultant to Monica Yuhas. Beth was also a volunteer for the Monica Yuhas for County Board Supervisor campaign. Beth designed mailings for Monica Yuhas for County Board Supervisor and also designed literature, managed the Facebook page, and campaigned directly for the Monica Yuhas for County Board Supervisor campaign.

Upon information and belief, this coordination was facilitated by Joseph D. Clark of 4862 105th Place, Pleasant Prairie, WI. Clark was the Secretary/Treasurer of the Kenosha Cares Coalition Inc. and Kenosha Cares Coalition, an independent expenditure committee, until March 21, 2020. Clark assisted Monica Yuhas by hosting planning meetings in the basement of his place of business, Tirabassi, Felland & Clark, LLC, 8035 22nd Avenue, Kenosha, WI. Clark purchased a voter list for \$455.00 from the Wisconsin Elections Commission Badger Voters website on January 23, 2020. He then "voter scored" the voters on the list and distributed the list to Monica Yuhas. Monica Yuhas either reimbursed Clark in cash so there was no evidence of the transaction, or an intermediary accepted the cash and distributed it to Clark. Clark also assisted Monica Yuhas by signing and mailing out "Join me" mailing postcards which were postmarked March 20, 2020.

Upon information and belief, Monica Yuhas for County Board Supervisor violated Wisconsin State Statute 11.1101(3)k when Kenosha Cares Coalition sent out a mailer in support of Monica Yuhas for County Board Supervisor. The cost of that mailer exceeded the allowed limit under 11.1101(3)k for contributions to a candidate from an independent expenditure committee when the independent expenditure committee coordinates with a campaign.

Upon information and belief, Monica Yuhas is subject to the penalties and prosecution in 11.1401(1)a and 11.1401(1)c.

I, Michael Skalitzky, being first duly sworn upon oath, state that I personally read the above complaint and that the above allegations are true and correct based on my personal knowledge and, as to those allegations stated on information and belief, I believe them to be true.

EXCLUSIVE: How Dustin Beth Conned Young Cons

Show biz is apparently the new term for manipulation, fraud, and deceit.

Dustin Beth stumbled into the political scene at a young age. His inexperience, however, quickly spurred his downfall, as one failure led to yet another. From a student government impeachment scandal to a poor track record in campaign work, DBC Management Company's CEO, Dustin Beth, has a murky past he's unable to cover up. And, believe us, he's tried.

By fabricating a phony identity of a young entrepreneur worth millions, Beth has used glitz and glam to lure unsuspecting children into what appears to be a feebly scheme.

Here's what we know:

Dustin Beth's story is one made possible by layers upon layers of deceit. For starters, on numerous occasions, Beth bragged to his clients that he owned a private jet that he had use of at any time. When confronted he said, "I did have a friend who had a jet that they let me use. I sometimes have a habit to adapt ownership but, yes, I have used one."

Beth has claimed to clients that he owns a "penthouse" in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. In reality, he lives in a house given to him by his late grandparents.

Regarding his finances, Beth has reported a net worth of \$8.7 million. In a statement made via Twitter on Sunday evening, he fessed up, "I try to make people think I have more money and connections than I do".

Beth alleges connections with Koch Industries, RNC Chairman Reince Priebus, Sheldon Adelson, and other big name politicians. He also has a history of claiming connections in the entertainment industry with

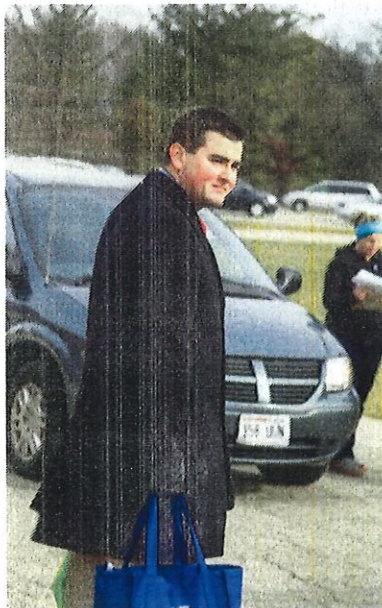
music icons such as Tina Turner and Patti LaBelle, and he has even claimed to work with current pop superstar Ariana Grande. People close to the situation have been able to confirm that he has no such relationships. As per his comment regarding his deceptive millionaire claims, "I try to make people think I have more money and connections than I do"

When it comes to Beth's relationship with Republican Party Chairman Priebus, former DBC Management client, CJ Pearson, claims to have spoken with a source close to Priebus who reaffirmed to him our suspicions that they do not have a relationship Dustin Beth, neither professionally or personally.

After an article (<https://medium.com/@CJ.Pearson/the-man-behind-the-curtain-481a89789df9>) criticizing Dustin Beth was released by CJ Pearson on Saturday, July 11th, Dustin made his rounds, attempting to cover his tracks by manipulating his victims into blindly supporting him again.

"I want you to know that...every time we have communicated or worked together I've been nothing but honest with you," Beth said in a voicemail to Matt Dallas. He added, "I've always put Christ at the center of my business, and would never jeopardize that moral standard."

Referring to claims made in the article (<https://medium.com/@CJ.Pearson/the-man-behind-the-curtain-481a89789df9>) released by CJ earlier that day, Dustin wrote on his personal Facebook page that, "Everything is completely unfounded and untrue. I have chosen not to play the proof game."



The next day, Beth released a letter to the people he had "wronged," including the following statements:

EXCLUSIVE: How Dustin Beth Conned Young Cons

"In all of this I have come to see the web of untruth that I sowed myself."

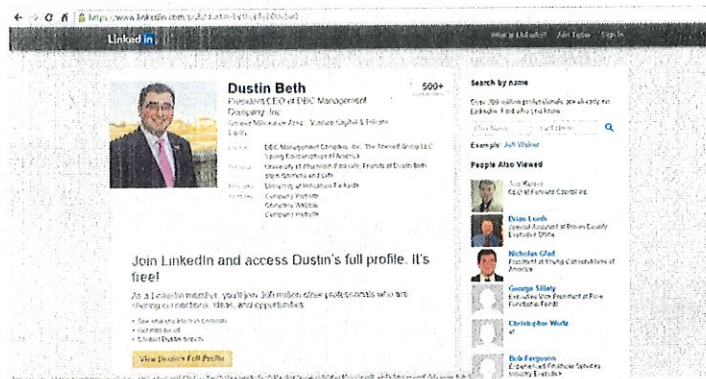
And

"I try to make people believe that I have more money and connections than I do. This is wrong."

Beth claims to own multiple businesses, including, but not limited to, DBC Management Company Inc, Trievad Group LLC, Forward Capital Inc, and DBC Music Company Inc.

DBC Music Company, Forward Capital, and Trievad Group are all without a website at this time. Trievad had an active website until Saturday, July 11th.

On his business card and on his LinkedIn, which he recently disabled, Dustin lists himself as, "President and CEO" of DBC Management, the "DB" representing his initials.

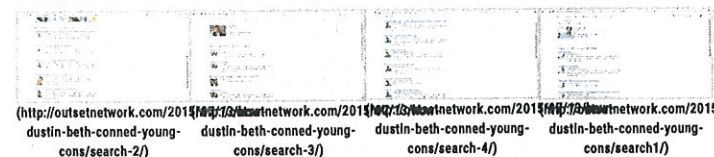


In the chaotic wake the article by CJ Pearson left behind on Saturday, July 11th, Dustin stripped the website of DBC management nearly bare. Leaving only the home page behind, the "about us" page, however, is still intact but only reachable via knowing the correct URL (<http://www.dbcmanagementcompany.com/about-us.html>).



When viewing the "About Us" page, it lists 4 Staff members, including, "CEO" Isaac Pierce, "CFO" Carl Schnable, and "Client Relations" staff Caroline Beek and Bradley Grosh. All of these names have pictures, as well as a brief biography.

Upon further investigation, all 4 pictures were stock images easily found on a Google Image search. This was discovered via reverse image search on Google Images.



"Isaac Pierce" is also said to have founded the company, despite Dustin listing himself as founder, president, and CEO in the past. It appears that "Isaac" has been "running" it for some time. It is clear, however, that none of the staff listed on the about us page are real people, as all of the images are obtained from search engines.

Here's what we believe:

Dustin Beth appears to be a classic con-man, similar to Madoff or Ponzi. Even with his meticulous planning and fabricated lifestyle, he failed to cover his tracks, allowing a group of politically-inclined teenagers to expose his fraud and dismantle his scheme. Beth spent a great amount of time trying to convince people that he was being honest, and trying to manipulate his victims into silence.

With the facts presented in this and other posts, one of two things must be true: either Dustin is trying to con credulous minors out of money, or he is just an amateur. As he ironically likes to say, "Either you're playing dumb, or it isn't an act."

Before CJ Pearson's article was released, he promised his wide-eyed victims the moon and stars. He can now barely muster up a half-hearted apology via Twitter, in which he took responsibility for the lies about his wealth and material possessions.

Beth's unprofessional behavior concerning contracts is a powerful testament of his inability as a businessman and fraudulent lifestyle as a human being. They are written to hold the "talent" responsible for following strict rules, and there isn't anything holding him accountable to delivery. The contracts are incredibly unclear as to what Dustin's role is, as well as what his responsibilities are as the manager. He essentially leaves as little control as possible with the client. Even more shocking, he charges most clients "retainer fees" which is rare for someone working as a "Personal manager, adviser, and representative."

Perhaps worse than a faulty contract, Caroline Stout never received even a document to consider, even after working with Dustin for over a month, and having been formally announced as a speaker on the "Rally Millennials 2016 Tour," a speaking tour run by Beth, featuring young conservative activists. In an unusual move, he used the young activists he brought on as speakers to "fundraise" for the tour.

"50 stops, 27 States, 3 months" he'd say incessantly, as he had these young people sell advertisement space to fund the tour, setting a firm \$100,000 - \$200,000 goal per speaker. In the statement he made, coming clean about his actions, he said, "This was their tour- it was their effort not mine." He made this statement, despite the fact that he has said, "I'm in control...I'm the manager, you have limited control in this operation... That's showbiz."

It is clear that Dustin Beth is nothing more than a below-average, everyday college student with a knack for subpar sales techniques, posing as a small-time publicist to make a quick buck from unsuspecting minors who don't know the difference between a legitimate business deal and a complete scam. He has proven himself to be a pathological liar with countless examples where he intentionally deceived clients, co-workers, and people close to him for his own personal benefit.

When he was finally exposed as a fraud, Beth executed weak attempts to destroy the reputation of the

people he felt were a threat to his questionable livelihood. Long story short, Dustin Beth is a fraud, and is not to be trusted in any business relationship. His story should serve to teach young people interested in advancing their careers, political or not, to be wary of who they involve themselves with.

School Board member Beth defends business ambitions, ethics

"The Rally Millennials 2016" tour was the brainchild of Dustin Beth, designed to feature young conservatives from across the nation and rake in thousands of dollars in profit.

Beth said he hoped the project would have a budget of more than \$1 million. But the money was not there, and the tour was canceled.

Now Beth faces allegations that he is a con artist.

A handful of conservative activists, some under age 18, have taken to the Internet to voice their complaints about the 21-year-old University of Wisconsin-Parkside student and Central High School Board member.

They say Beth misrepresented himself as a multimillionaire political activist with a private jet who could make them stars on conservative media outlets.

Activists upset

Thirteen-year-old activist C.J. Pearson, who has appeared on cable news and reached millions through his YouTube videos, said Beth lures young politicians with promises of meeting high-profile Republicans and finding lucrative networking opportunities.

Pearson said Beth would boast about connections with Gov. Scott Walker, Republican National Committee Chairman Reince Priebus and county officials.

"These aren't allegations that only I have brought against him," said Pearson, a Georgia resident known for his viral video "President Obama: Do you really love America?" and for interviewing Republican presidential candidate Sen. Ted Cruz. "These are allegations from former clients, former employees, former friends and people inside of Kenosha."

Pearson said Beth reached out to him via social media and that the two agreed to work together.

Pearson said he did not give Beth any money, but that their deal would have worked on commission, with Beth taking about 20 percent of any money earned by Pearson from paid appearances.

That agreement ended in early July, after Beth posted a termination letter online in which he said Pearson engaged in "fraudulent communication" and "inappropriate behavior," including forging his parents' signatures on their contract, which Pearson denies.

Beth responds

Beth denied the allegations of wrongdoing in an interview with the Kenosha News this week, sitting alongside his father, Kenosha County Sheriff's Lt. Bill Beth, who declined to comment.

"I have never once frauded someone, I have never once conned somebody," Beth said. "I am not that type of person. Am I someone who talked with high ambitions and goals? Absolutely. Does that make me a criminal? Does that even make me a con man, a scam artist, a fraud? No."

Beth said he apologized for making Pearson's termination letter public and that his past business dealings should not disqualify him from serving on the School Board.

He said he hopes to use this experience as a reminder to always put his

faith in Christ first.

"There's is a lot of things, material things in this world, that can drive a person," Beth said. "This is a result of me not putting Christ at the center of things."

Other clients react

Ohio State student Matt Dallas published a letter for the conservative website Outset claiming Beth charged some clients "retainer fees" and offered others unusual commission agreements.

Dallas, 20, told the Kenosha News that he did not sign a contract with Beth but started working with him in April.

Their relationship ended in June. Dallas said he is grateful he never paid Beth anything.

But not all of Beth's clients were so dissatisfied with his services.

Megan Stoner, a 17-year-old from Indiana, said she and Beth "did not see eye to eye on every issue" but she appreciates Beth for being there for her when she needed him.

She would not say how much she paid him.

"My family and I are quite satisfied with the services from Dustin. Our business dealings are private but I will say that every dollar spent was worth it," she said in a statement.

Beth declined to say how much money he made from his services.

Website confusion

Beth's business website for DBC Management Co. Inc. is no longer active and its information has been scrubbed.

The website's "about us" page featured photos of young professionals who joined DBC Management and text boasting their years of experience.

Those photos, however, turned out to be stock photos.

Beth said the photos and biographies were posted by mistake, because of the website's GoDaddy design template.

Of the canceled million-dollar tour, Beth said, "This was an idea that could change the way politics is run forever, putting young people in the spotlight. I spoke big, with ambition and goals."
